The change is noted in bold:

**SOCKS:** Socks must be worn. Socks must be solid white, black, khaki, or navy blue and be able to be seen above the shoes. Knee high, bobby socks, or tights may be worn. **A small brand logo on a solid colored sock is permissible: example a small black Nike swoosh on a solid white sock.**
