them very soon.

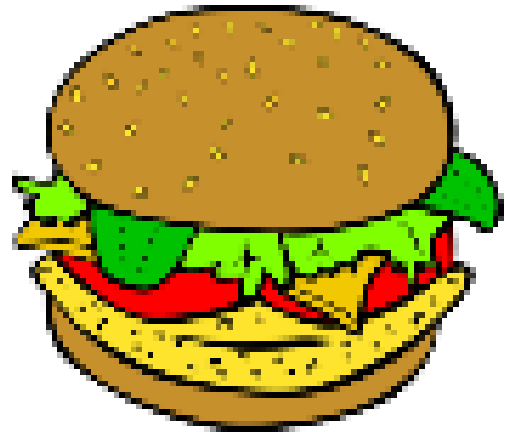
