Registration for the 2017-2018 school year will begin on the Monday of Catholic Schools Week, January 30th, 2017. All current Prek-8 grade families have priority to register for the 2017-2018 school year. Please be sure to register before February 20th, 2017. Preschool and K-8 registration will open to active registered parishioners on February 20th, 2017. We have very limited spots in some grade levels. Please be sure to register your family to ensure your enrollment. We currently expect 24 students from our preschool to join the Kindergarten class. This leaves only 4 open seats to get to the 28 student Kindergarten capacity. Full classrooms is terrific for our school and community. I want to make sure all current returning school families get registered prior to February 20th, 2017. Please be sure to turn in your registration and registration fee prior to February 20th, 2017.

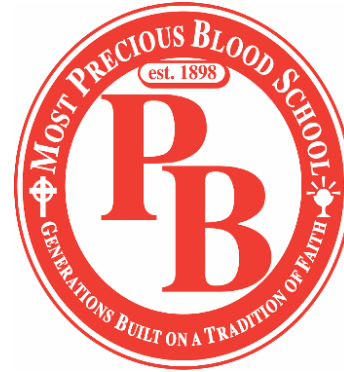
