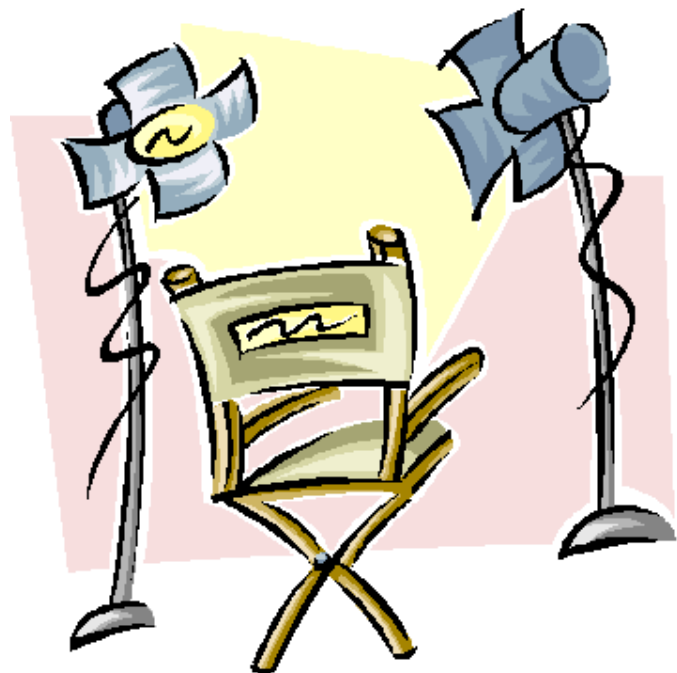


It's that time of year again! CYO Saints Wrestling season. For those of you new to the sport of wrestling we welcome all wrestlers from beginner to advanced to join our team. Our team is comprised of 5<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade students from St. Vincent, St. Charles, St. Jude, OLGH, Precious Blood, Q of A, SJNH and others. We teach the fundamentals of wrestling and provide the opportunity for your wrestler to compete in matches as a CYO Saint.

We will get a kick start to our season with December conditioning practices starting on Dec. 6<sup>th</sup> at the BD wrestling room from 5:30-6:30pm. Registration will be available during the December conditioning practices so please accompany your wrestler to the wrestling room to complete registration before our Jan. 9<sup>th</sup> season start.

The Saints wrestling season formally begins on Jan. 9<sup>th</sup> and runs through early March. Practices during the season will be Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 5:30-7pm at the BD Wrestling room. We wrestle in about dozen match competitions (dual and tournament style) to increase your wrestler's experience in the sport. Less experienced wrestlers are paired up with opponents of the same weight and skill level. For Middle School there are 17 weight class divisions starting at 75 lbs and run up to heavyweight (<275lbs) so we need all sizes from the smallest to the largest at any skill level.

TARDINESS A student is considered tardy if the student is not in the classroom (Kindergarten - Grade 3) or not in their classroom seat (Grades 5-8) at the final bell at 7:55a.m. each morning. Students who are tardy report to the office for a Tardy Slip to be presented to the classroom teacher. Parents should also call the school before 8:30a.m. if a student is going to be late. If a student arrives after 7:55a.m., **a parent / guardian must sign the student in at the office.** For each tardy the student will receive a Tardy Notification slip which is triplicated for the office, teacher, and parents.
