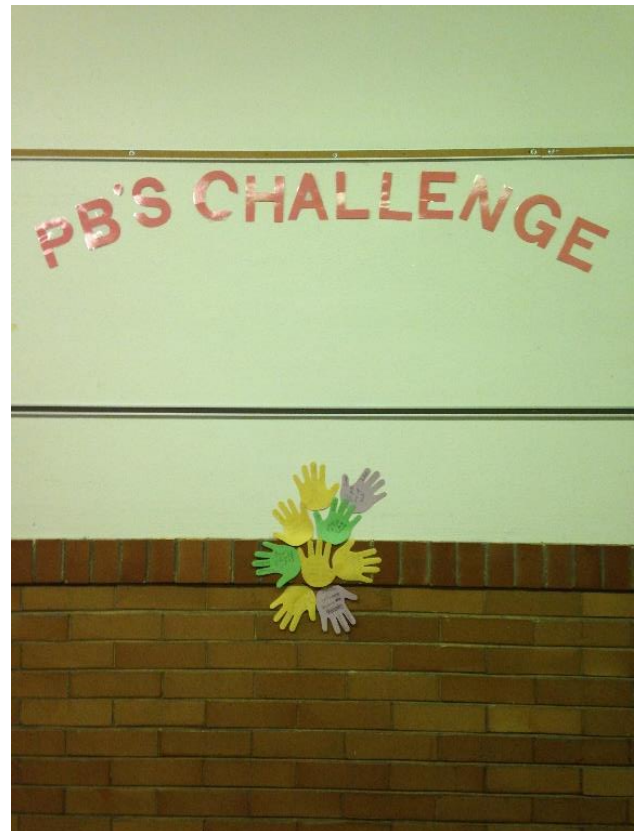

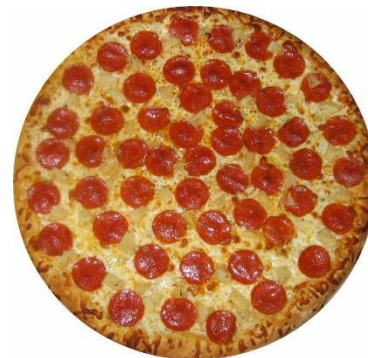


NED's visit to PB was awesome!
